MASKS: As of today we are going to have masks be optional at this time. We recommend that all students wait INSIDE the studio at all times while waiting for their ride home from classes. It is for the safety of all of our dancers! Our younger dancers should have their parents walk them to and from classes each week.

With the weather changing, please be sure not to drop your child off at the studio without checking to make sure that the studio doors are open. And as usual, students are to be dropped off and picked up no more than 10 minutes before and after their class time.
